THE ASCENSION OF JESUS...TESTING OUR MINDS....


The Ascension of Christ is one of those mysteries that can test us, at least test the rational part of our minds. Like the Resurrection, the Ascension reveals the ability of God's divine power to go beyond the limits of the physical world. Also both events reveal to us Jesus' obedience to the authority of his Father.

Throughout his earthly ministry, Jesus was always pointing away from himself, and instead pointed to his Father. Even as he nears his ascension, he points away from himself, to the coming of the Holy Spirit. He continually reinforced that any authority he did have was the due to living in relationship with the Father and the Spirit, and with others.

When we reflect upon this, how much of a challenge this could be if we let it. In a world and society such as ours that values individualism above all else, the image of the relational union of Father, Son and Spirit is a strong challenge (and cure?) for the culture of self-centredness and self-reliance that is found so much in our society.
