On this Trinity Sunday, let us spend a moment thinking about the way the three persons of the Trinity draw us into their realms of activity.

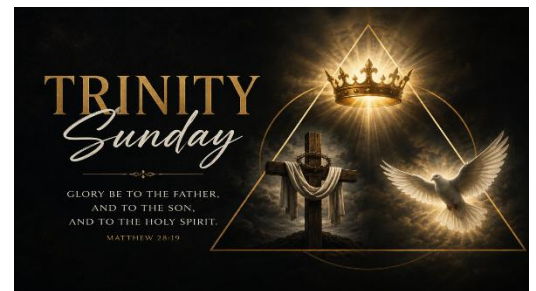
