The Transfiguration of the Lord

From Fr. Ron

'This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!'

The mountain has often been the meeting place between God and his people.

Moses received the Ten Commandments on the mountain: on the mountain Elijah found God in the gentle breeze. Now Jesus brings Peter, James and John to the mountain.

There he is transformed; his clothes become a brilliant white.

There he speaks with Moses and Elijah. From an overshadowing cloud God's voice speaks: *'This is my Son, the Beloved; with him I am well pleased; listen to him!'*

The awe and wonder of the three apostles soon changed to confusion as Jesus asked them not to speak of the experience until the Son of Man was raised from the dead. How can a Messiah suffer? Why would he freely choose to suffer? Like the apostles, we do not understand. But we too try to hold and remember this glimpse of the fullness of God's life in Jesus as we travel together the road from slavery to freedom, from death to new life.




