#### REFLECTIONS ON THE GOSPEL - John 10:11-18

Christ is Risen

Alleluia!

He is Risen Indeed

Alleluia

The good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep

'I am the good shepherd' is one of seven statements in John's Gospel in which Jesus defines his mission and the qualities needed to accomplish it. That it captured the imagination of the early Christians is evident from their many artistic depictions of Jesus in that role; and, in our own day, the popularity of the 'shepherd psalm' (Psalm 23) in funeral liturgies indicates a similar preference.

Jesus returned to this image when he applied it to the mission of his disciples, especially those called to servant leadership. 'Feed my lambs; feed my sheep' is his command to Peter (John 21:15-17).

Jesus' words, 'I know my own and my own know me', are both comforting and challenging. There is no doubt that he knows and loves us intimately. But how well do we know him? Risen Faith and Peace to you. Fr Ron.
