## DAY OF PENTECOST

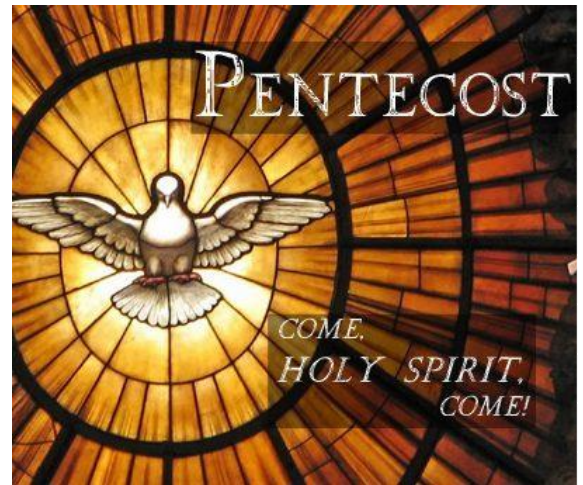
### 'RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT . . .

have shown. Amen*

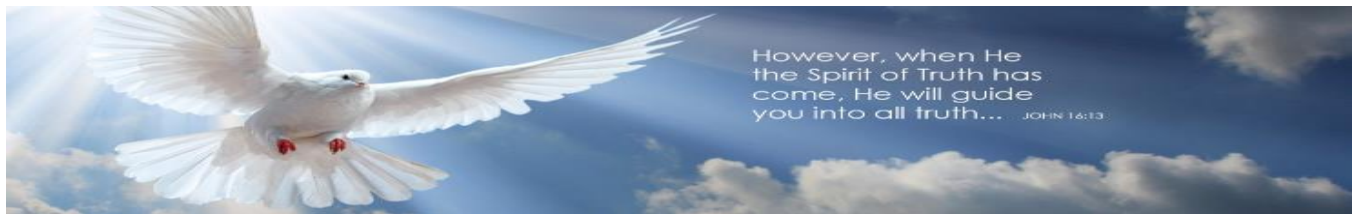


**ZOOM MORNING PRAYER – NEXT SATURDAY (3<sup>rd</sup> June @ 8AM....**
